On Monday, 30 March, the school library hosted the final round of this year's Spelling Bee competition. The event included the three top-performing students from each of the three Year 6 English groups, who had previously qualified during the semi-final rounds.

A Spelling Bee is an academic exercise where participants are required to spell a series of words orally. The competition aims to help students improve their vocabulary and understand the origins and structures of English words. Contestants must listen to the word provided and recite the letters in the correct sequence to avoid elimination.

During the two rounds of the competition, the nine finalists were required to spell a variety of increasingly difficult words. All participants were very well prepared, and the competition was notably challenging. Due to the high level of performance across the group, the judges awarded two 1st places, two 2nd places, and two 3rd places.
